The Saskatchewan Band Association has established this program to provide a summer band camp opportunity for Saskatchewan students at a reasonable cost. Day camps are offered in Regina, Saskatoon and Yorkton, with Regina and Saskatoon offering optional overnight dorming. The Kenosee Junior Camp is a full residential camp offered at Clearview Camp in beautiful Kenosee Lake Provincial Park.

Each camp offers comprehensive instruction for woodwind, brass and percussion students who have one or more years of playing experience.

The camps are designed to assist in the improvement of performance skills that relate directly to the positive experiences of playing in a large ensemble. The camp provides an excellent way for students to learn new musical and technical skills, make new friends, have fun, and improve sound and technique.

Students will be assigned to a band on the first morning of camp, according to their musical experience and performance ability.

The camps include full band, private lessons, sectional instruction, small ensembles, master classes, theory, ear training, rhythm training, sight-reading, staff performances, recreation and social activities, and a final student's public concert.

Junior Camps: Student who have completed one year of playing up to and including grade 9.

Senior Camps: Grades 9 - 12

RECREATION

It is not all work at SBA Camps. Although music is the focus, recreation and fun are an essential ingredient in the overall camping experience. In addition to breaks and free time, each day, a wide-array of planned activities keep students active and involved. Depending on the particular camp, students participate in a wide variety of activities during scheduled recreation periods. The fun continues into the evening with activities such as dances, movies, student talent night, faculty recitals and other concerts.

JAZZ OPTION

Camps may offer a Jazz component. This option will be for interested students who have at least one year of experience in a Jazz Band.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Saskatchewan Band Association offers scholarships for students who may not be able to attend due to financial reasons. SBA Scholarship applications are made by Band Directors on behalf of students. Please contact your band director if you are interested in a scholarship due to financial circumstances. Other scholarships may also be available through community organizations, service organizations, music booster groups, and your local school.

ROOM & BOARD

Saskatoon and Regina - additional cost - \$275.00

Room and Board for the Saskatoon and Regina Camps will be provided for those who choose and will be fully supervised by camp staff. The cost of \$275 per week includes all meals and accommodation for the duration of the camp.

Kenosee Lake - cost included in registration fee: The Kenosee Jr. Camp is held at Clearview Church Camp in Kenosee Provincial Park. This is a residential camp where all students and staff stay on-site in cabins. All accommodations and meals are included in the Camp Registration Fee. Space for this camp is limited so register early.

ELIGIBLE TAX DEDUCTION OF \$150

Fees paid for the Summer Band Camp Program are an eligible deduction for the Saskatchewan Active Families Benefit. Parents or legal guardians of children six to fourteen years old are eligible to claim an annual tax benefit of up to \$150 per child per taxation year. Please keep your receipt in order to claim this benefit on your income tax.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Ensure that the completed and signed Registration, Health and Consent Form is enclosed with full payment, to ensure your registration is processed promptly. Space may be limited at some camps; please register early to avoid disappointment. If the camp is full, your fee will be refunded.

All early-bird registrations and fees must be postmarked on or before June 25, 2010. After the early registration deadline, all fees must be submitted at the regular price.

Registrations accompanied by post-dated cheques will not be processed until the date listed on the cheque, and fees as of the date of the cheque will be applicable. Cheques may not be post-dated later than one month prior to the start of the camp.

A \$25 fee will be charged on all NSF cheques, and registration will be cancelled.

Organizations submitting one cheque, for full or partial scholarships, must indicate the name of the student receiving the scholarship, and the camp the student will attend.

Additional registrations from the same, immediate family receive a \$10 discount per additional registration.

Please do not phone or fax registrations. All information specific to each camp will be posted on the SBA Website.
