

## **David Dick**

Dr. David Dick is the Principal Trombone of the Regina Symphony Orchestra and Assistant Professor for the Department of Music at the University of Regina, where he teaches jazz, music theory, brass classes, and applied trombone lessons. His previous teaching appointments have included University of Memphis, Jackson State University, Belhaven University, and Briercrest College. Before returning to Regina, he was Principal Trombone of the Mississippi Symphony Orchestra.

Dave is in demand as a clinician and adjudicator, regularly working with bands, jazz bands, and soloists at regional and provincial music festivals, in addition to performing recitals and giving masterclasses. Dave is one of the Coordinators of the SBA's Prairielands Jazz Camp and has been an Instructor at the Regina Band Camp for a number of years.

As an active musician, he continues to perform in a wide variety of settings including orchestras, chamber groups, early music ensembles, jazz ensembles, and blues bands.
